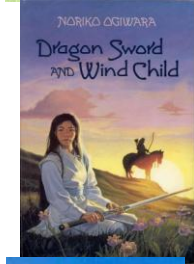
OVERBOARD

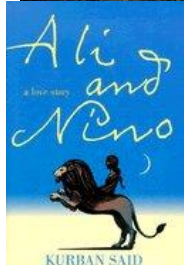
AN OCEAN APART, A WORLD AWAY

Yanyan dreams of being a doctor. However, in China in 1921 this dream is nearly impossible.



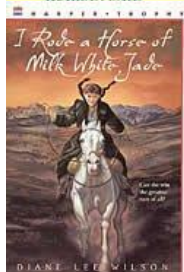
DRAGON SWORD AND WIND CHILD

Oyuna disguises herself as a boy and embarks on a journey to restore good fortune to her clan.



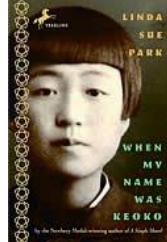
THE GHOST IN THE TOKAIDO INN
