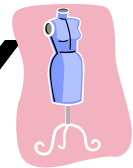


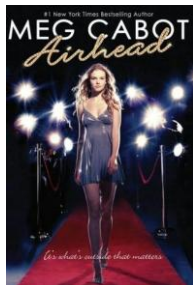

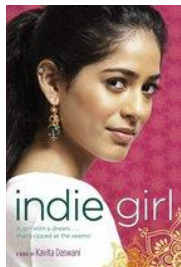
After a TV falls on her, Em's brain is transplanted into the body of the supermodel Nikki who has suffered a brain aneurism.

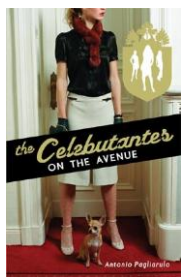
Fashion obsessed Imogene gets herself a great internship in New York until a cute boy and evil intern threaten to ruin her plans.

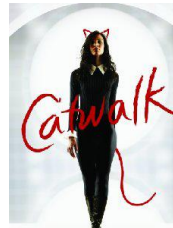
Indie takes a job babysitting Celebrity Style's fashion editor Aaralyn's kid, to try and further her dream of being a fashion reporter.
