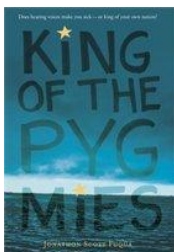

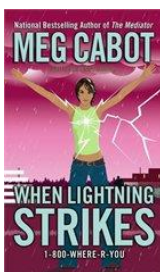
#### **Tattoo**

After applying temporary tattoos, four friends are given extraordinary powers and must use them to fight a dangerous enemy.



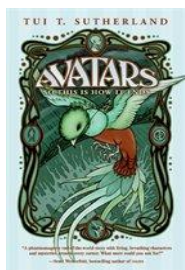
#### **King of the Pygmies**

When Penn starts hearing voices his mother thinks he has schizophrenia. But is he really crazy, or can he hear thoughts like his uncle says?



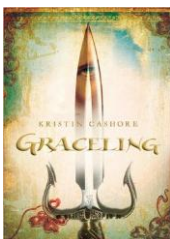
#### **When Lightning Strikes**

Katsa is a graceling – someone in her land born with an extreme skill. Hers? The ability to kill a man with her bare hands.



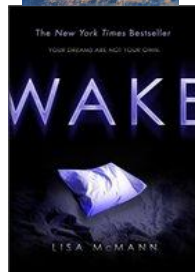
#### **Vibes**

At midnight, for a whole secret hour, everyone in Bixby, Oklahoma freezes. Everyone except the Midnighters.



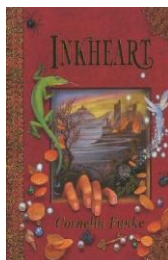
#### **Wake**
