



By Catherine Fisher


A boy trapped in a living prison, and a girl trapped in an arranged engagement, become entangled in an assassination plot and an escape attempt.

By Scott Westerfeld


In a world of large airships, two teens on opposite sides of World War I find themselves aboard the Leviathan airship on a round the world adventure.

By Caitlin Kittredge


Aoife – from a family where everyone goes mad on their sixteenth birthday – tries to pretend her fate can be different. But a letter from her mad brother changes everything.
