







Still mourning the loss of her father, Macy's carefully planned summer changes when she takes a job at Wish Catering and meets the tattooed and artistic Wes.


After receiving life-altering bad news, Ben Wolf decides not to tell anyone, to live his last year as he sees fit and to hopefully win over the girl of his dreams.


Chloe and Shana want the same thing – for everything to go back to normal, the way it was before their mom went to the hospital. But both sisters know that things can never be the same.




